Community Reinvestment Act

Assessment Area:

The boundaries of our assessment area coincide with the boundaries of Thurston County (Olympia MSA 36500), Mason County (non-MSA area) and Lewis County (non-MSA area) in the State of Washington.

Our Main office (established in 1906) and West Olympia branch (opened 1972) are located within the City of Olympia limits, the county seat for Thurston County and our State Capitol. Our Lacey branch (opened 1981), Yelm Highway branch (opened 1995) and Hawks Prairie branch (opened 2006) are all located within the City of Lacey limits. Our Tumwater branch (opened 1983) is located within the City of Tumwater limits. Our Yelm branch (opened 2015) is located in the City of Yelm limits. Thurston County consists of three main cities – Olympia, Lacey and Tumwater, where most of the commercial activity is conducted. To the southeast, south and southwest are several small communities.

Our Belfair branch (opened in 1978) is located within the Belfair city limits, an unincorporated city in North Mason County. The City of Shelton is the Mason County seat and is where most of the commercial activity is conducted. Several small communities are located to the north and east of Shelton.

Our Chehalis branch (opened in 2025) is located within the Chehalis city limits in west Lewis County. Chehalis is the seat for Lewis County and serves as the primary center for government and trade within the county. The city of Chehalis is bounded on the north by the city of Centralia, which is the largest city in the county, and on the south and east by unincorporated Lewis County.
